Coordinators

The coordinators will work closely with community leadership and Health will be responsible for communicating with the membership. Liaise with community, providing information as it becomes available on prevention measures. They will also be responsible for working with the membership to identify needs and organize a response. This will include recruiting and organizing volunteers.

TRAVEL BAN

ALL Work-related Travel is CANCELLED for First Nation Employees.

All NON-URGENT Medical Appointments should be rescheduled or cancelled by the patients as well unless it was cancelled by the place of your appointment already.

If you are travelling out by Winter Road please notify Coordinator April Sofea or any of the Chief & Council members. All individuals arriving into the community, if you are coughing or not feeling well you should self-isolate and notify the nurse of your situation. Also inform your supervisor that you are sick and will work from home.

Communication

Supplies and Walkie Talkies have been secured for our community and will be distributed once they arrive in the community. Cleaning supplies and toilet paper will be distributed with priority given to Elders & families with small children and individuals who can't leave their homes.
